Role Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cultivate a culture of ongoing gratitude and encouragement within the service unit.</li> <li>• Form and manage a recognition committee of 2-4 volunteers.</li> <li>• Actively seek out new people to nominate to build engagement with newer leaders while still thanking long term, high performing volunteers.</li> <li>• Encourage and educate troop leaders and volunteers on the nomination process and types of awards.</li> <li>• Initiate and support the nomination process and ensure nominations are made by the deadline.</li> <li>• Coordinate with committee members and service unit team to plan a service unit event to recognize and thank leaders.</li> <li>• Plan and implement frequent informal recognition at service unit meetings and social media shoutouts.</li> <li>• Opportunity to work with the Service Unit Business Manager and/or Service Unit Manager in collecting volunteer tenure information for service unit milestone recognition.</li> <li>• Opportunity to partner with the Event Consultant to create a Bridging Ceremony and/or a Bronze &amp; Silver Ceremony for girls.</li> <li>• Able to check email and Facebook regularly through the membership year and answer questions within 24-48 hours.</li> <li>• Participation in the Recognition Chair Facebook group for networking with other volunteers is encouraged but not required.</li> </ul>
