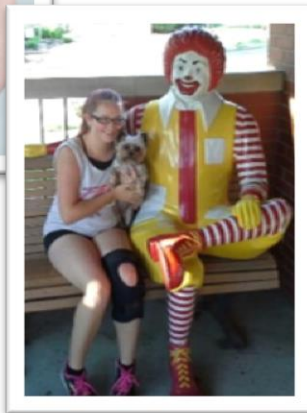


**Kresynda Robinson**
