



Brownie First Aid Badge

Pillar: Life Skills

Outcomes: Community Problem Solving

Brownies will earn their badge by:

1. Find out how to get help from 911
 - a. Write your name, phone number and address on an index card. Then learn how to dial 911 on a phone and practice talking with the “operator” (guardian) to report some emergency situations
2. Identify someone who treats injured people
 - a. Research some first responders and draw what they look like and what building they work at (firefighter, police, nurse, doctor, paramedic, etc.)
 - b. Write a letter or email, create a drawing or record a video to send to some of the first responders to thank them for their service to your community.
3. Make a first-aid kit
 - a. Decorate a portable box or bag to place first aid items in and then fill with items with your guardian(s).

4. Learn how to treat minor injuries
 - a. Discuss how you would use the items in your first-aid kit and practice on a stuffed animal, doll or guardian.
5. Know how to prevent and treat outdoor injuries
 - a. Identify what the following items would be used for: Bug spray, Sun screen, Bug bite ointment, Poison ivy ointment, Life vest, Water, Bike helmet
