



Brownie Making Games Badge

Pillar: Civic Engagement/Life Skills

Outcomes: Develops a strong sense of self, Seeks challenges and learns from setbacks, and Forms and maintains healthy relationships.

Brownies will earn their badge by creating new games and sharing them with others.

1. Try a scavenger hunt:
 - a. Pick an area for your scavenger hunt, like your living room or back yard.
 - b. Make a list of at least 10 things to find or touch, then search for them with your family. For more fun, try to find things in your home from another country!
2. Make up a mystery game:
 - a. Mysteries turn simple games into adventures! Sharpen your detective skills with a mystery box game. Find a large box and have an adult help you cut a hole big enough for your hand to fit through.
 - b. Then place 10 -12 objects in the box and have your family write down what they think each object is just by touching it. Whoever gets the most correct answers wins!
3. Create a party game:
 - a. In Pin the Tail on the Donkey, blindfolded players try to pin a paper tail on a poster of a donkey. Pick a new matching pair for your game – maybe Brownie Elf and her hat, a nose and a teddy bear, or an octopus and eight legs. Create the game with materials at home and then play with your family.
4. Change the rules:
 - a. To play Hopscotch, you draw squares from 1 to 10 and then hop your way upward without touching any lines. What if instead of numbers, you had to hop from animal to animal? Or your hopping pattern was a circle or hexagon? Or you had to do a new action – like spin or sit – in each square? Make the rules, create your play pace, and then play with your family.
5. Invent a whole new sport:
 - a. Create a new sport with the materials and space you have available at home. It might be throwing tennis balls at your basketball hoop from different points in your driveway, or backyard soccer while riding on stick horses, or tag croquet. Create your sport, gather your equipment, and then teach your family.
