



## Brownie Pets Badge

**Pillar:** Life Skills

**Outcomes:** Strong Sense of Self & Healthy Relationships

### Brownies will earn their badge by:

1. Find out what care different pets need
  - a. Pick a few of your favorite stuffed animals that could be pets (or pick a pet you don't have that you want to learn more about). Find out what they eat, where they sleep, and how they protect themselves. Tell your family members what you learned!

2. Keep a pet comfy
  - a. Create the ultimate napping spot for your pet and snap a picture of them at their comfiest. Or, stage a photoshoot with your stuffed animals indulging in self-care.
