- 1) Decide who you are

 - b) Read about that time period and decide where in the world you would like your character to be from.

- 2) Create a costume
 - a) Find some images of what girls/women wore in the past time you are focusing on.
 - b) From clothes you already own, recreate some of these outfits and show them off in a fashion show for your family, friends or troop members.
- 3) Experience daily life
 - a) Research a recipe and make a typical dish a girl from that time period might have prepared for her family.
