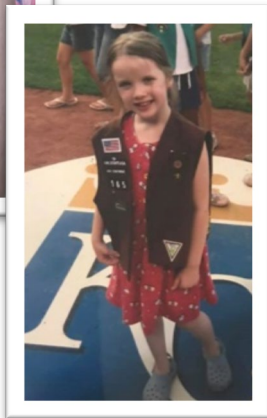


## United States Interactive Playground Map
