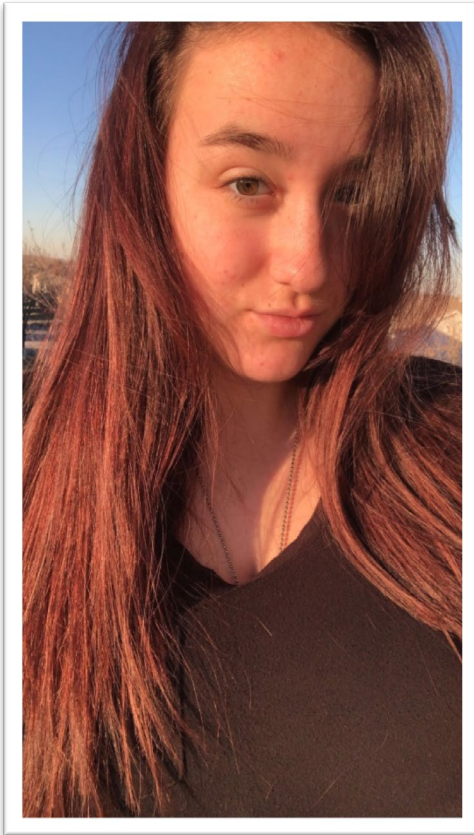


Teen Suicide Awareness & Prevention

Sheigh's Gold Award Project addressed the rise of teen suicide, which is the second leading cause of death for those aged 15 through 24. She created an informational video about the statistics surrounding suicide and how to get help. The video has been implemented for students in her high school and other counselor's offices around the Kansas City area.

Sheigh worked with community programs such as Liberty Youth Alliance to provide it with access to the video to use in its own programs. She believes the most successful part of her Gold Award Project was being able to connect to people and listen to what they or someone around them has been through.
