Build a bird nest!	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Build a bird nest out of recycled materials! <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Birds use items they find in their environment like twigs, grass, fur, feathers, and mud to build their nests. ○ Have your troop make nests out of recycled or scrap materials like paper strips, pipe cleaners, popsicle sticks, toilet paper rolls, anything that is available! • While girls are building their nests talk to them about birds building nests to take care of themselves and their family. Ask the following questions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ What are ways that you can take care of animals? ○ What are ways that you take care of yourself? ○ Are the ways that we take care of animals like the ways that we take care of animals? How are they the same and how are they different.
