



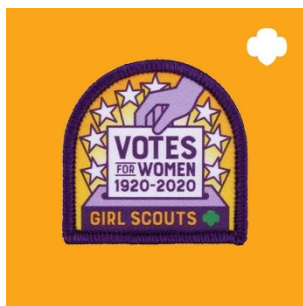
Family Fun – Women’s Suffrage Patches

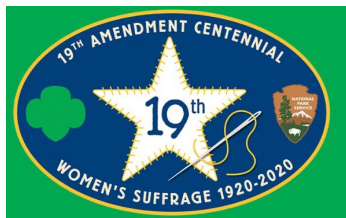
