Memorial Day

Visit a cemetery to pay tribute with flowers or flags for family members or Veterans. Contact your local cemetery to see if they have a flag program or a service you can be involved in. Rose Memorial

Help support the Rose River Memorial (<https://www.roseriver.memorial/>) project by creating felt roses. Each rose represents a person in Missouri that has died from COVID. Over 6000 roses will be created and displayed together as powerful public memorial.

Rose kits can be purchased from ScrapsKC. Each kit contains 10 precut roses, thread if you are sewing your rose, and a video tutorial to be emailed (1 for sewing roses, 1 for gluing roses).

Finished roses will need to be returned to ScrapsKC to be included in the art project. You may purchase a prepaid return label, mail them back yourself (address listed below), or bring them to our retail store during store hours.
