

The Community Partnership Award

Description

The Community Partnership Award recognizes a group in the community who has partnered with Girl Scouts and whose service has resulted in outstanding benefits to girls in single service unit. The award is given in the form of a plaque.

Nomination

A nomination form is completed and submitted to the council's recognition committee, along with supporting documentation indicating how the nominee meets the criteria. The recognition committee reviews the nomination documentation, then approves or denies it.

Criteria

The group has made an outstanding contribution to the success of Girl Scouting in the service unit and/or whose services have expanded to reach girls in more than one service unit.

Nominee Examples

- *A synagogue that supports Girl Scouts by identifying adult volunteers for troops plans and carries out a month long Girl Scout volunteer recruitment drive and, as a result, doubles the number of troops.*
- *A woman's organization that has provided 12 program mentors for girls on the service unit level expands to include program mentors for 2 additional service units.*

Nomination Description Examples

Vague & Non-Specific Nomination Description

The Jackson County Advocate developed a partnership local Girl Scouts and wrote articles highlighting events.

More Specific Nomination Description

Over the past two years the Jackson County Advocate has researched and written 5 articles on Girl Scout Leadership Experience in their newspaper.

The Corporate Partnership Award

Description

The Corporate Partnership Award recognizes a group in the community who has partnered with Girl Scouts and whose support exceeds expectations of their partner agreement and benefited girls' council-wide.

Nomination

A nomination form is completed and submitted to the council's recognition committee, along with supporting documentation indicating how the nominee meets the criteria. The recognition committee reviews the nomination documentation, then approves or denies it.

Criteria

The group has exceeded expectations of the partner relationship, which has benefited girls throughout the council.

Nominee Examples

- *A corporation sponsored an 8 week STEM program, including employee volunteers for multiple service units.*
- *A skating rink owner, who has provided low cost skating fee and safety clinics to Girl Scouts, contacts other operators throughout the council and expands programs to all girls in the council.*

Nomination Description Examples

Vague & Non-Specific Nomination Description

Wallace Insurance Corporation held its annual golf tournament to support Girl Scout program.

More Specific Nomination Description

Wallace Insurance Corporation held its annual golf tournament and presented Girl Scouts with a check for \$10,000, which will support the Outreach program.
