

The Service Unit Community Partnership Award

Description

The Service Unit Community Partnership Award recognizes a group in the community who partnered with Girl Scouts and whose service has significantly benefitted girls. The award is given in the form of a certificate.

Criteria

- There is a current partnership agreement between the group and the Girl Scouts.
- The group has made a significant contribution to the success of Girl Scouting.

Nomination

- Submit request for the service unit community partnership certificate by email to your membership manager.
- Maintain record of honoree in council office.
- Arrange for appropriate presentation of the certificate (service unit recognition event, ceremony at place of business, program site, etc.)

Nominee Examples

- *A partnership with a church to recruit mentors for girl's results in twice as many volunteers due to the organization's promotion and enthusiasm.*
- *A community center that has consistently provided low cost programs to Girl Scouts hosts an all-night camp-out when weather interferes with the plans.*
