Community Champion Award



Description

The Community Champion Award recognizes a group in the community for their support of Girl Scouts at the Service Unit level. The award is given in the form of a certificate.

Criteria

• The group has made a significant contribution to the success of Girl Scouting in a specific Service Unit.

Nomination

- Nominations for the Community Champion award are approved by the Recognition Chair, Recognition Committee and Service Unit Manager.
- The certificate template is located on the GSKSMO website at Volunteers>Adult Recognition> Annual Service Unit Recognition>Community Champion Award Certificate.
- The Service Unit Recognition Chair or Service Unit Manager will keep a record of honorees.
- Arrange for appropriate presentation of the certificate (at a Service Unit Recognition event, ceremony at the business, program site, etc.)

Nominee Examples

- A local church has helped to recruit mentors for girls. This has resulted in twice as many volunteers due to the organization's promotion and enthusiasm.
- When inclement weather interfered with plans for a Service Unit campout, the community center offered use of their facility. The community center has also consistently provided low cost programming to Girl Scouts.
