

Day Camp Cookie Dough and Fall FUNds

What are Cookie Dough and Fall Funds?

Cookie Dough is a credit that may be earned by Girl Scouts during the annual Cookie Program. Fall FUNds are earned during the annual candy, nut and magazine program. Girls choose to earn 'Dough' or 'FUNds' in lieu of another recognition item; this information is communicated to the troop cookie manager by the girl and is ordered when the troop places their recognition order. Girls can use Cookie Dough or Fall FUNds earned during the membership year to offset the cost of Day Camp.

How does a girl know how much Cookie Dough/ Fall Funds she has?

If a girl earned 'Dough' or 'FUNds' they receive notification in the mail however the mailing is not required to be turned in to be used.

How do we redeem Cookie Dough for Day Camp?

In the case of Day Camp, parents simply check a box on the Day Camp registration form and note how much credit is being used. Day Camp volunteers will fill out the reimbursement form located below and online at gsksmo.org/forms. This form is then emailed (directions are on the form) to the Product Sales team who will verify the amounts requested and work to provide your SU with reimbursement. Please expect this process to take 3-4 weeks (from form submittal to reimbursement).

Can we check Cookie Dough amounts before we submit this form?

Day Camp volunteers can request a list of girls in their SU that earned Cookie Dough by emailing cookies@gsksmo.org. Please make this request at least three business days before the list is needed and note that we can only provide a list that is current at the time it is ran.

Do we have to use the form below?

Day Camps are welcome to submit their own excel versions of the form but please be sure to provide the same data as requested on the PDF. The excel form should be attached or included with the PDF and the Day Camp contact info should be filled out.
