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Activity Chaperone: Drives and/or serves as helper for trips, etc.; part of the adult/ girl ratio			
Badge Planner: Plans badge/journey activity based on girls' choices			
Field Trip Coordinator: Plans and organizes trips			
Meeting Helper: Helps with activities at meetings; works with the girls			
Service Project Coordinator: Helps the girls to plan community service projects			
Snack Coordinator: Organizes rotation of snacks and reminds families of their turn			
Troop Photographer: Takes photos and posts to social media			
Treasurer: Ensures bank account is open and accurate; knows council financial policies/procedures; helps girls budget; keeps records/receipts			
Service Unit Meeting Sub: Attends SU meeting to gather important info regarding events, policies, etc. and brings info back to leaders/troop			
Candy, Nut & Magazines Helper: Organizes sale in the Fall; handles deposits, etc.			
Cookie Program Helper: Organizes cookie sales; sets up booths; manages inventory & deposits; ensures incentives are distributed to girls			
Cookie Booth Chaperone: Attends sale with girls; ensures safety			
Adventurer: Plans outdoor and adventure activities; may need to be lead if leaders are not available			
Camping 102-Trained Parent/Caregiver: Troop camping requires at lease 1 adult who has taken this training with our council			
Camp Parent/Caregiver: help with all aspects of camping; attend trip			
Day Camp Parent/Caregiver: helps with day camp activities; attends day camp			
Outdoor Team: organizes outdoor activities such as camp fires, outdoor badges, or overnight camp out
