



LEAD Troop Recognition Form - Instructions



Leadership – Essential Elements – Achievement – Determination

Girl Scouts are able to participate in the LEAD troop patch program by completing activities that align with the Girl Scout law. Upon completion in the spring, troop leaders can order a special patch to identify each Girl Scout as part of a LEAD troop. Be sure to check out the LEAD(er) opportunity for additional recognition for your hard work as the troop leader!

Tips to successfully utilize the LEAD troop patch program:

- Lead a discussion with your troop of what the Girl Scout Law means to the girls and how different activities model the Law. This can be a useful planning tool at the beginning of the year!
- The LEAD Troop Recognition Form is a great way to share with families the activities your troop has participated in and how these activities embrace the Girl Scout Law.
 - You can print the form after you complete it to share at an End of Year Celebration, Bridging or Court of Awards Ceremony.
 - Share the form with family members to review the troop's experiences for the year.
 - Girls can use the form as part of a ceremony and recite lines from the recognition form.
 - Engage older Girl Scouts by asking them to help fill out the LEAD Troop Recognition form, using their own descriptions of how their activities connected to the Girl Scout Law.
