

Service Unit Positions and Role Description

Day Camp Director

Recruits and leads the day camp staff to host a day camp. This position requires the ability to manage volunteers, conduct meetings, complete safety and logistical information deadlines and motivate girls and adults.

Day Camp Business Manager

Works closely with the Day Camp Director to manage the budget, verify that all forms are completed in a timely manner and provide support to the day camp staff.

Service Unit Manager

Leads the service unit by providing coaching and motivation for service team volunteers, troop leaders, parents/caregivers and girls. This position requires the ability to conduct meetings and complete safety and logistical expectations, including meeting deadlines.

Service Unit Business Manager

Works closely with the Service Unit Manager to manage the budget, verify that all forms are completed in a timely manner and provide support to the service team.

Event Consultant

Oversees the creation, marketing, and execution of service unit events designed to meet the needs and interest of girls and further the Girl Scout mission.

New Leader Liaison

Builds a relationship with new leaders to help them to feel connected with their service unit, and shares service unit information needed to be successful and confident in their first year.

Recognition Chair

Ensures that volunteers feel supported, recognized, and appreciated on a regular basis.

School and Community Liaison

Connects the staff recruiter to opportunities in the community and schools to bring prospective families to Girl Scouts.

Service Unit Product Program Manager - Cookies

Provides leadership for the service unit during the annual Cookie Program.

Service Unit Product Program Manager - Cookie Cupboard

Facilitates ongoing cookie distribution for the service unit during the annual Cookie Program.

<u>Service Unit Product Program Manager – Fall Product</u>

Provides leadership for the service unit during the annual Fall Program.

Troop and Program Consultant

Provides support and guidance to troop leaders on troop management, program content, and badge activities.
