Criteria

• The group has made a significant contribution to the success of Girl Scouting in a specific service unit.

Process

- Nominations for the Community Champion Award are accepted by any volunteer in the service unit and approved by the Recognition Chair and Service Unit Manager.
- The nomination process and volunteer recognition plan are determined by the service unit and do not need council approval.
